




A Cultural Venue for Somerset

The development of The Octagon Theatre continues to move forward with principle funding from Department of Culture, Media and Sport (DCMS), Yeovil Town Council and our existing and ongoing fundraising and other sources. Somerset Council continues to manage and deliver the project, a contribution received as support in kind.

A revised Outline Business Case relating to The Octagon Theatre has been developed and submitted to DCMS, which sees a revised development project costing £15m. The Project Team, led by Somerset Council, are in the process of appointing architects and a design team to take the revised project forward. The planned scheme is for a full refurbishment of The Octagon Theatre ensuring we are fit to welcome future generations, improving access backstage and front of house, creating a more environmentally sustainable operation and improving the technical capabilities of the theatre.

Over the year we have continued to fundraise to support the redevelopment of our much-loved theatre, with community productions, bucket collections and 24-hour dance-a-thon's. Additional funds including fundraising contributions through the Foyer Club Charity, grant funding, sponsorship and donations will continue to be sought to support the development of the venue and to help deliver the project.
