




Your Visit to Westlands Entertainment Venue

- 1. Westlands Entertainment Centre has one entrance.
- 2. If you need to buy a ticket, the Box Office is straight ahead inside the entrance.





3. The foyer has a bar with drinks and snacks, and a seating area. There are toilets in the foyer and off the Ballroom.



- 4. The concert will be in the Ballroom. There will be sofas and seats to sit on, and some beanbags on the floor.
- 5. You can use your e-ticket or printed ticket to find your seat. It will have the show, time and seat number on it.







- 6. The stewards will be wearing black and white clothes. They can help you get to your seat, and will help you if you need anything or have a question.
- 7. When the concert starts the lights will go a little darker but they will stay on.
- 8. The audience will clap when the concert starts and between the musical pieces. You are allowed to join in.
- 9. During the concert our presenter, Polly, will tell you about the music that will be played and introduce you to the musicians.







- 10. There will be 10 musicians from Bournemouth Symphony Orchestra and their conductor, Dougie, performing the music.
- 11. You are free to move about, dance, and make noise during the concert.
- 12. There is no break in the performance but the doors will remain open and you can leave the Ballroom at any point. There will be a chill out area in the foyer if you want to go somewhere quiet.
- 13. At the end of the performance people may clap loudly. You can join in, or if you don't like the noise you can cover your ears.
- 14. When the concert has finished, the lights will come back on and you will leave the Ballroom. There will be other people leaving too. It may be crowded and noisy.
